Emergency Procedures

Building Evacuation

Due to fire, gas leak / public safety concerns.

If you see something, say something. Report suspicious & unusual activity to campus security or police - call 9-1-1.

- Upon activation of the building's fire alarm, proceed to the nearest exit/stairwell; DO NOT use elevators.
- If safe & able, assist those requiring further assistance.
- Proceed to the designated Emergency Assembly Area to: ٠ 1. account for all building occupants,
 - 2. take note of those requiring further assistance, and
 - 3. report to campus and/or public safety personnel.
- DO NOT reenter the building until given the 'All Clear'.

Chemical Spill

Hazardous materials release.

- Safety: ensure you and those around you are safe.
- Isolate: deny entry and isolate the area if possible.
- Notify: call UCLA EH&S at 310-825-9797 or dial 9-1-1.

Fire

Rescue, Alarm, Contain, Extinguish & Evacuate

- **Rescue** anyone in immediate danger of the fire.
- Activate the nearest fire alarm pull station & call 9-1-1.
- **Contain** the fire by closing all doors to the area.
- Extinguish small fires if safe to do so with a fire extinguisher: Pull the pin, Aim at the base of the fire, Squeeze the handle, & Sweep side to side.
- Evacuate the building safely.

Earthquake



Drop, Cover & Hold On! until the shaking stops

Evacuate due to fire, gas leak, and/or immediate danger.

Lockdown / Secure-In-Place

Acts or threats of violence against the campus community may prompt a campus lockdown.

SECURE-IN-PLACE by seeking immediate shelter, conceal

yourself, and barricade yourself from danger if needed.

- Remain guiet, silence devices, and turn off the lights.
- Follow the direction of public safety personnel.

In the face of immediate danger, RUN-HIDE-FIGHT:

- If there is an escape path, **RUN** to a safer place.
- If you can't escape, find a place to HIDE.
- If you can't run or hide, as a last resort, FIGHT!

Medical Emergency

Call 9-1-1 & ask for permission to assist/help.

DO NOT move the person unless they're in immediate danger. Provide available aid and reassure the person until help arrives.

Shelter-In-Place

Seek immediate shelter inside a building, preferably in an interior room.



- Close all doors, windows & shades where available.
- Remain indoors for your safety & the safety of others.
- Follow the direction of public safety personnel.
